



This will be a series event with a finale in December 2022. 80% payback at all events with 90% payback at the finale. Bulls don't have to be ABBI registered unless you are entering in a sanctioned event that you are paying the optional \$100.

Check out each month's event flyer for divisions and fees.

All riders must sign a release before competing.

At first event entered for each bull, a \$30 annual membership will be due. For owner/trainers with multiple bulls a one-time annual membership of \$300 can be purchased.

During the series events, a bull can be entered in any of the three divisions throughout the year. For example, a bull can be entered in the open and at the next event dropped to a \$15,000 or \$7500 claimer, or a bull can be entered for \$7500 and at the next event entered for \$15,000 or in the open.

For a bull to be eligible to enter the finale, each bull must have competed in at least three of the series events.

At the finale, each bull is eligible to compete in the last division entered with no claiming option. If a bull has competed in a lower division during the series events than the last division competed in; that bull is eligible to enter the lower division at the finale; however, can be claimed for the division price. For example, if a bull has been entered for \$7500, but the last event entered was in the \$15,000 division; that bull can be entered at the finale in the \$7500 division; however, can be claimed for that price. In either scenario, the bull must have been entered at least one time in the same division in the series events that is entered for the Finale.

Entries close on the Tuesday prior to event at 8pm. Entry fees will be paid in cash the day of the event no later than 9am.

At time of entry the following information will be needed: brand number, owner/trainer information, and signed entry form.

Day sheet will be posted no later than 3 days prior to event for review.

Bulls must be branded for identification.

### On Claiming Events

If a bull is registered, owner/trainer must bring an original copy of registration papers ready to be transferred if bull is claimed.

Bulls cannot leave premises until the conclusion of each division.

Claim cards must be dropped on the Futurity Events no later than 9:00am and no later than 1:00pm for the Derby Events.

Claims will remain sealed until the end of each division, claimed bulls will be announced with the results of the event.

If multiple claims are dropped on a single bull, at the conclusion of that division, dice will be used to determine the winner by the highest number rolled.

A claim cannot be placed by an owner/trainer that owns all of or a portion of a bull that the claim is placed on.

On a bull that a claim card is dropped on, if he leaves the chute, ownership will transfer regardless of injury in the arena.

**On a claimed bull that places in the money, the prize money from that event will go to the individual who entered the bull not the claimee.**

Owner/trainer certifies that by submitting the entry form, they have the permission and authorization to enter the bull in a claiming or open event. Owner/trainer understands that if a claim is dropped on their bull, ownership will transfer to the claimee when the bull clears the gate.
